Actions

Use

Skin Conditions

Damaged and ageing skin.

Wrinkles, scars and pigmentation or depigmentation (vitiligo).

Ideal to prevent and to slow down the ageing process.

Home Use

Evening

Nucléa is to be used in very small quantities over Synchro on areas that need more regeneration such as wrinkles, scars and pigmentation.

It can also be used all over the face, neck and eye area to slow down the ageing process.

In case of vitiligo, Nucléa is applied before Synchro on the white patches.

Nucléa can be used 2 or 3 times a year in courses of 1 jar.

Salon Use

Step #6 of Skin Care Treatment

Face treatments

Nucléa is applied on top of Synchro on areas that need regeneration such as ageing, wrinkles and scars.

Body treatments

Use Nucléa after Synchro when a deep regeneration is needed, such as scars and stretch marks.
